Awareness – Think like a journalist Activity 1

How to decide whether a source should be trusted

Steps:

- 1. The story where did you get the information?
- 2. The author who is telling story you heard/read, and what do you know about them? They may have a reason for bringing it to the public or they may have made mistakes. Make sure they had at least two sources to verify a story.
- 3. Check a fact does all the evidence add up? Find out if there are any first-hand reports and if the facts are repeated in other credible sources.
- 4. Expert advice is there another version of the story? Look at different opinions and see who else is telling the story or is sharing information.
- 5. Images is there a video, graphic or are there pictures in the story? Review them using the reverse image search.
